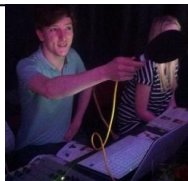

Past experience and training:

Pennine Care NHS Foundation Trust (Communications Assistant) – Writing articles for the website and regional press on new health services, updates, events and patient case studies; along with news, bulletins and reports to update over 5,500 staff and partners. In addition, I film and edit video content to support news, recruitment and health campaigns. I also create and schedule content for the main Trust and recruitment social media accounts, monitor a further 20 accounts and deliver training to nominated staff members. My other duties include updating general content on the website and intranet, photography support, arranging advertising for services and responding to incoming queries. November 2015 to present.

Stockport NHS Foundation Trust (Pharmacy Non-Sterile Production Operator) – Repackaging, over-labelling and manufacturing pharmaceutical products and labels, to a high level of precision and accuracy, in a non-sterile production unit. August to November 2015.

Vavel - Writing analysis and features for the Manchester City section of VAVEL, an international online sports news website. August 2015.

ITV Granada Reports – Paid work filming general views and interviewing MP candidates during the general election in Hyndburn. Two days observing the production process of the 6pm news, weather and complementary online content. This involved shadowing journalists, observing the gallery during broadcast and providing second opinions on editing and quality. May/January 2015.

BBC Radio Lancashire (placement) – One week spent contributing to news meetings, attending press conferences, verifying facts and researching topics or features for the drive time and breakfast shows. I was also able to research, collect and edit and package, which was aired on the Saturday morning breakfast show. January 2015.

Frequency Radio (Station Manager – Programming and Presenter) – My primary roles included planning the station's schedule, ensuring each show follows the station's theme and that they maintain a professional quality. Other duties were to attend promotional events, recruit and train new hosts, liaise with the other student media outlets and hold meetings to relay information to the rest of the team (Aug 2014 – July 2015). In addition I hosted and produced an award winning weekly two hour show, which won *Media Programme of the Year* at the 2013 UCLan Student Union awards. Oct 2012 to July 2015.

Manchester's Finest online magazine (placement) - Pitching and developing feature ideas, writing film previews, music reviews and sub-editing copy for the website. I also watched a live musician and wrote a review for publication the next day. April 2014.

Preston FM (training and presenting) – I successfully passed a course with Preston FM which developed knowledge and understanding of key elements when planning for and broadcasting through radio, using different audio outputs and meeting law requirements. April 2013.

PR1 Magazine – Writing analytical reviews of live performances, under strict time constraints, for a prominent feature in the music section of PR1 magazine and PR1 online. Furthermore, I developed different features to help improve the quality of the magazine and website. From October 2012 to May 2013.
